## Topic Five – The Gospel to the Nations for the Producing of the One New Man: Its Vision, Burden and Coordination

Scripture Reading: Gen. 1:26-28; 6:6-7; Eph. 2:14-15; 4:20-24; 1 Tim. 3:15-16; Matt. 24:14

- I. God's desire and purpose of eternity: a corporate man Gen. 1:31; Eph. 3:10-11; Eccl. 3:11
- II. The fourfold fall of the created, corporate man issuing in rebellion unto division Gen. 6:3; 11: 7-9:
  - A. The first fall from God's presence to man's conscience Gen. 3:1-24.
  - B. The second fall from man's conscience to others' control 4:1-26.
  - C. The third fall from others' control to human government 6:1-8:3.
  - D. The fourth fall from human government to rebellion under Satan's instigation 11:1-9 [see footnote two of verse 7 on "confound."]
- III. The God of recovery moved on from the created race, next to the called race, then to the church and now finally with the overcomers to bring forth through the overcomers the one new man in this age Eph. 4:13; Matt. 24:14:
  - A. Being built up into one in the Father's name by the eternal life (John 17:6-13); in the Triune God through sanctification by the holy Word (vv. 14-21) and in the divine glory for the expression of the Triune God (vv. 22-24).
  - B. For the expression of the one new man corporately Gal. 3:27-28; Col. 3:9-11.
- IV. Endeavoring to match the Lord in His heavenly ministry Acts 17:26-29a:
  - A. The demographics within the churches in the U.S.
  - B. The surfacing of this burden.
  - C. The resulting prayer and fellowship.
  - D. Recent coordination and learning.
